4 <sup>th</sup> Period	70% of Journeyman Wireman \$42.88
5 <sup>th</sup> Period	80% of Journeyman Wireman \$49.01
6 <sup>th</sup> Period	90% of Journeyman Wireman \$55.13

## Fringe Benefit Contributions

#### Health & Welfare: ..... \$15.60/hour worked.

First Period apprentices receive \$7.80/hour worked prior to September 1, 2023. First Period apprentices receive \$15.60 per hour worked September 1, 2023 and after.

### Retirement:.....\$13.50/hour worked.

First Period apprentices do not receive retirement trust contributions. All other apprentices receive \$4.50/hour worked.

Industry Trust:	\$1.50/ hour worked.
National LMCC:	\$ .01/hour worked.
NEBF Pension	3% Gross Labor Payroll.
Local NECA Dues	1% Gross Labor Payroll.
