**Public Works Contractors Registration Renewal** The Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) reminds currently registered public works contractors that [registration renewal](#) for the 2017/2018 fiscal year is due by this Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>. Contractors must be registered with DIR before bidding, being awarded, or performing work on public works projects in California. Registered contractors who fail to renew by June 30<sup>th</sup>, but continue working on public works after that date may be subject to late fees and potential penalties. DIR has extensive information regarding public works requirements on its [public works website](#), including instructions for [contractors on how to renew their public works registration](#).

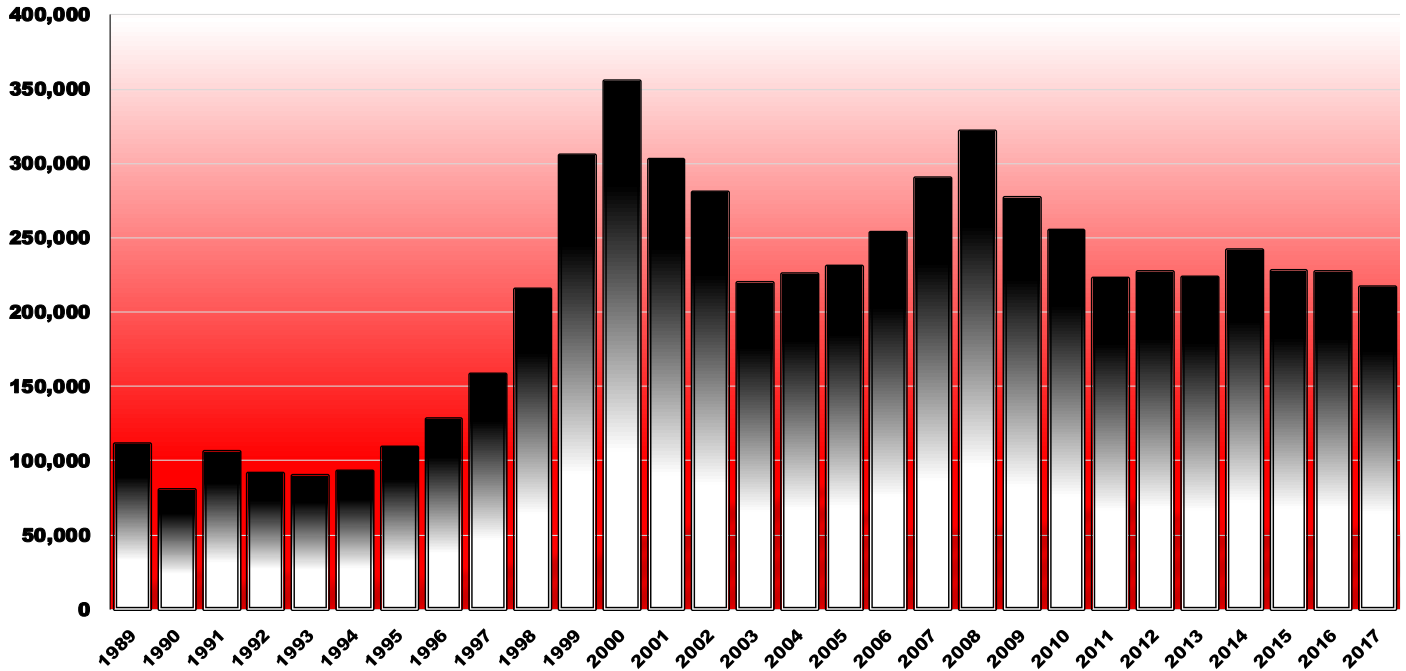

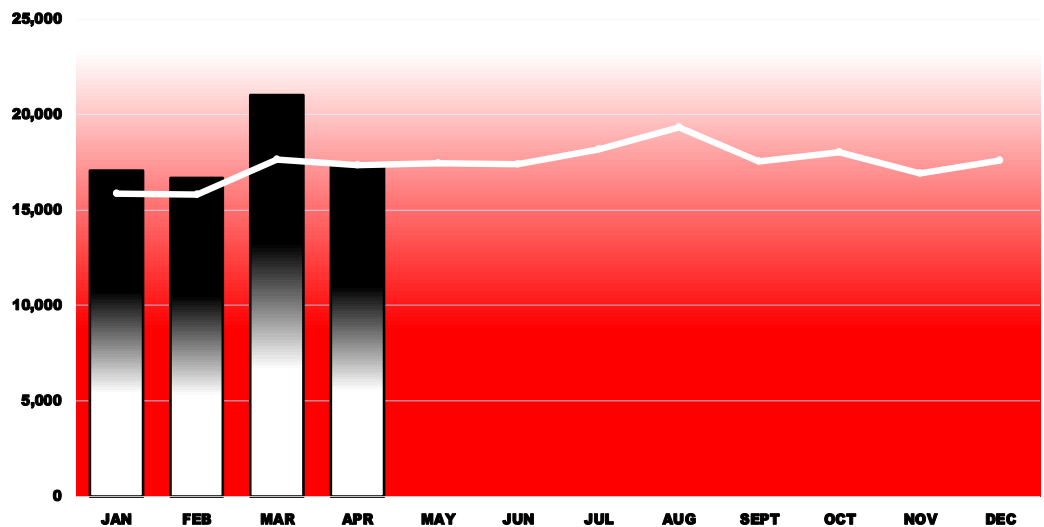
