

NEC 2014 Code Changes

If you missed the Code Committee meeting last week featuring Michael Johnston, Director of Standards and Safety for NECA, Inc., you can access his presentation on the <u>Most Significant Changes in the 2014 NEC</u>, which will become effective in California in January of next year. <u>Mr. Johnston</u> is Chairman of the NEC Correlating Committee, which makes him the person most responsible for the development of the National Electrical Code to make sure it is practical, enforceable and easily understood. Our NECA members throughout the country are fortunate to have him in that position. His presentation reflected his unmatched understanding of the subject matter. 




IBEW LOCAL UNION 302 Inside Wireman/Maintenance Manhours Worked


